Acts 3:1-10

**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**: Share a story from your life where, like the beggar, you've been "lifted up" by God's hand. Were there others involved in supporting you? Take time to praise God for these stories after sharing.

## Head

- 1. Where are Peter and John heading in vs. 1? What do you think their plans were?
- 2. List all the things we learn about the beggar in vs. 2. What is the most important detail for you?
- 3. Peter and John both look straight at the man (vs. 4). What is directing this unified reaction? Why is this significant?
- 4. What is the man's reaction after his restoration (vs. 8-10)? How does his testimony now affect others?

## Hands

- 1. Think of your community, who needs more than "silver or gold" (vs.6) but the restoring touch of God himself? Discuss ways your small group can serve these people together?
- 2. The apostles lacked money, but they had other gifts to share. Reflect on your unique gifting from The Spirit. Are your gifts in use? How can your group help these gifts to flourish?

## Heart

Are you or someone in your life in need of significant physical or spiritual restoration? Bring those people and situations forward in prayer.

Lay hands and pray for those needs together.
