Michael is of Korean descent, born in America. He received his BA, MS, and PhD degrees at the University of Pennsylvania. He also completed an MDiv at Trinity Evangelical Divinity School as well as an MA in Regional Studies, East Asia, at Harvard University.

He serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors for Christ Bible Institute, which he founded in 2004.

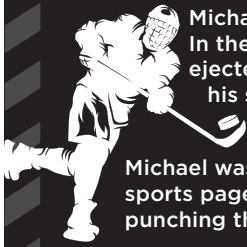

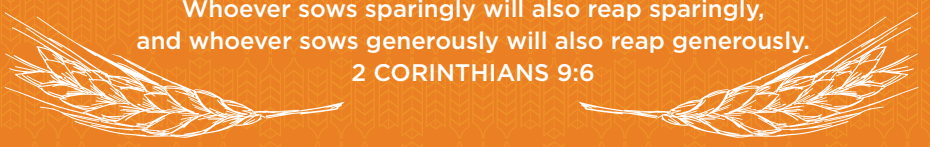
## HOW DOES IT WORK?

With this commitment, you put seeds in the ground that will yield a harvest.

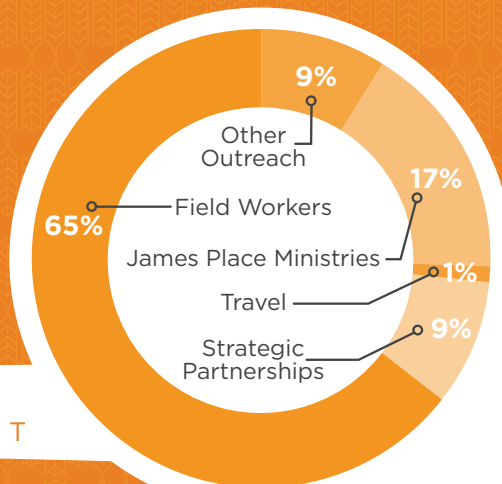
Our partners doing gospel work here and around the world will thank God for your support of the great mission Christ gave us.
