KNOWLEDGE/EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Satisfactorily completed one course in Early Childhood for credit or is enrolled in that course within 6 months after assuming the position.
- Registry certification within 3 month
- Infant CPR certification within 6 months
- Shaken Baby Syndrome Course
- Recognition of Child Abuse Training

OVER-ALL RESPONSIBILITIES:

To assist the assigned Teacher in supervision of a group of children

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING:

- 1. Offers a program that meets the emotional, physical, intellectual, social, and spiritual needs of both the individual and the group
- 2. Interprets and shares Christian Education curriculum and values with children
- 3. Interacts with the children and encourages their involvement in activities
- 4. Helps children develop self-help skills
- 5. Allows time for socialization
- 6. Assists in implementing large group and small group activities
- 7. Helps carry out a physical education program and participates in outdoor recess
- 8. Assists in class field trips if assigned
- 9. Uses appropriate and positive child management techniques
- 10. Supervises appropriate hand washing techniques
- 11. Supervises rest period if assigned

SPACE AND EQUIPMENT:

- 1. Prepares a safe environment that is orderly, clean, and appealing which permits the child to grow and explore
